



Vintage Sheet Dress


① Fold sheet to be 24" across from edge. Measure child from collarbone to the place you want the dress/shirt to fall. Add 2 inches to this measurement for seam allowance. Cut the fabric to that length (x).




② With fabric still folded and right sides facing out, stitch $\frac{1}{8}$ of an inch seam up the length of the fabric.




③ Fold wrong sides out (right sides together) and now stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch from the edge you just sewed together. You are enclosing all the raw edges into a little pocket for a finished edge (a.k.a. french seam)



④ Measure your child from shoulder to underarm (armpit). Measure width of arm (w). Now mark 2" from top of raw edges of fabric. Add this amount to length of shoulder, underarm measurement. Mark this on fabric, as shown on back side of fabric. Cut "J" shape using measurements as guides to form arm holes




⑤ Unfold fabric, wrong sides facing out & fold arm edges 1/4" in → press. Then fold in again 1/4" in → press again. Do this to both arm holes.




⑥ Sew arm seam closed.


⑦ Wrong sides out, fold fabric down 1" from top and press. Fold down again another inch, making a pocket for your ribbon and press.




- ⑧ Wrong sides facing out stitch $\frac{7}{8}$ " from top securing pocket for ribbon. Do this on both sides.



- ⑨ Cut ribbon into 2 24\" pieces. Add large safety pin to the end of the ribbon. Guide ribbon & pin into the pockets you just made.



- ⑩ Gather fabric and tie the two ends of ribbon together at each shoulder. Easy Peasy! The dress is done. Embellish with rick rack ribbon or whatever.



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
